Message from the President of the Board of Directors

Throughout another year, Feed the Hungry continued its activities in favor of the most vulnerable population in our locality.

This report presents a recount of the concrete actions carried out.

We began the year with significant plans and various proposals to extend our programs in schools, prioritizing rural communities considered marginalized.

As a child nutrition organization, nutritionists and chefs addressed dietary needs through the following programs:

- School Meals

- Nutrition
- Extended Feeding
- Early Childhood Nutrition
- Hydration

Hydration Program

The Hydration Program was established in 23 primary schools across communities, providing purified water jugs.

A total of 6,283 units were distributed annually, benefiting 2,597 preschool and primary-level children.

Nutrition Workshops and Activities

Engaging nutrition workshops and significant activities were conducted with children and mothers, including anthropometric measurements every 3 to 6 months.

Key achievements:

- 3,291 nutritional status evaluations of children
- 356 nutritional workshops for mothers
- 1,861 nutritional workshops for children
- 282 training sessions for volunteer mothers
- 127 training sessions for cooks

Expansion of School Kitchens

In January, April, and August, we successfully inaugurated three new kitchens in the primary schools of the communities:

- Don Francisco
- Peña Blanca
- Cañada de la Virgen
